How do we support and encourage help-seeking for NT children and young people?

Genuine engagement

Connect with and work with Cultural Leaders

TV and radio community

Purposefully seek out children and young people who may not readily 'come forward'

Increase flexible learning models

Use social media

Promote in venues where people go, eg.shopping centres

Skilled 'listening'

Create access pathways

Form own 'Whatsapp' group to share info

Information sharing between agencies

Trusted people and services (eg. coaches, schools, police etc) - know how to respond when children and young people seek help
