Reach out to new and young parents. Ask if you can help out in any way... with a meal, or to mow their lawn. Every little bit of support helps.

Think about safe and respectful ways to be an active bystander if you see an adult being inappropriate towards a child or young person.

When you see or hear of good things about members of the family, make sure you let the family know and **congratulate them.**
